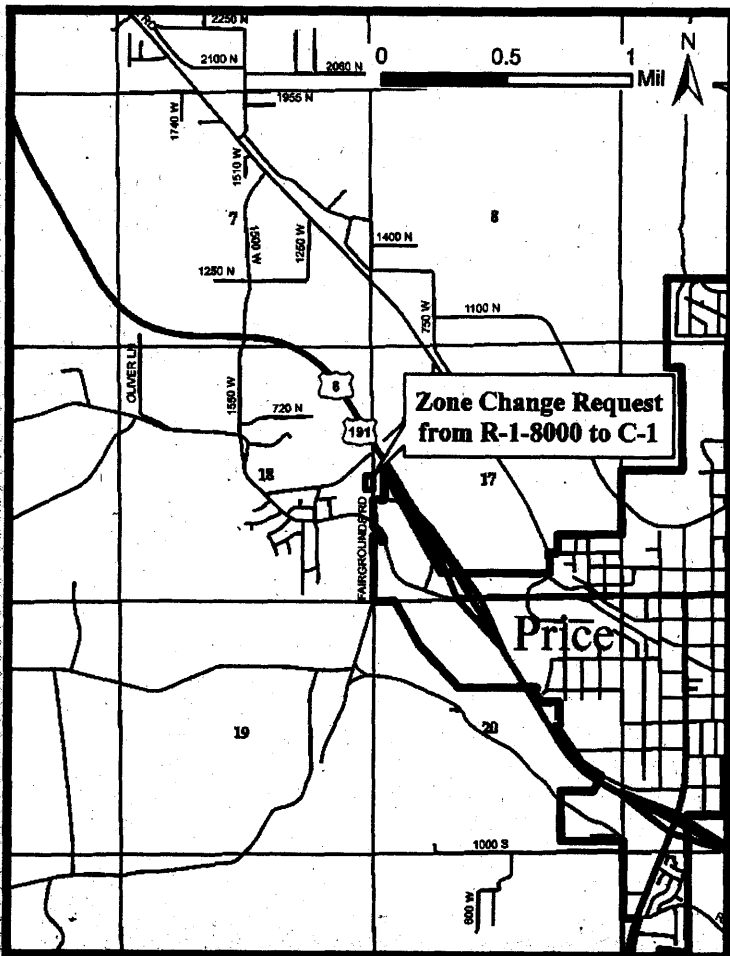


**Description of Location:**

A parcel of land located in Carbon County, State of Utah, which is located in the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 18, Township 14 South, Range 10 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, being further described as follows, with a bearing of North 00°23'23" West, between the Southeast corner and the East quarter corner of said Section 18, used as the basis of bearing.

Beginning at the East quarter corner of Section 18, Township 14 South, Range 10 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, and running South 89°44'19" West along the center line of said Section 18, 215.07 feet; thence South 00°23'23" East, 312.76 feet; thence North 89°44'19" East 215.07 feet more or less, to the East line of said Section 18; thence North 00°23'23" West, 312.76 feet to the Point of Beginning.

**LEGAL NOTICE OF DECISION  
NON SIGNIFICANT FOREST PLAN AMENDMENT  
AQUATIC HABITAT MONITORING INDICES  
MANTI - LA SAL NATIONAL FOREST**

Alice B. Carlton, Forest Supervisor, for the Manti - La Sal National Forest signed a Decision Notice and FONSI (Finding of No Significant Impact) on May 31, 2006, that authorizes a non significant Forest Plan amendment. Specifically this forest plan amendment will change the type of appraisal method used for monitoring macroinvertebrates. The Forest will use macroinvertebrate monitoring methodology being developed by the Utah Division of Water Quality. Most of the baseline monitoring locations listed in the 1988 Water Quality Monitoring Plan, as called for in the Forest Plan, will be retained.

A written appeal must be postmarked or received by the Appeal Reviewing Officer within 45 days of the date of publication of this legal notice in Sun Advocate.
