

The project area is located about 22 air miles west of Castle Dale, Utah and 1 mile north of Joes Valley Reservoir in Emery County. The project is adjacent to the Reeder Subdivision and other private lands. The project will reduce fuel loading, stand and crown/canopy density, and the resulting fire hazard to ponderosa pine, the public, and private property within this wildland urban interface area.

This decision is subject to appeal pursuant to Forest Service regulations at 36 CFR 215. Appeals must meet the content requirements of 36 CFR 215.14. Only individuals or organizations who submitted comments or otherwise expressed interest in the project during the comment period may appeal. Appeals must be postmarked or received by the Appeal Deciding Officer within 45 days of the publication of this notice in the Emery County Progress. This date is the exclusive means for calculating the time to file an appeal. Timeframe information from other sources should not be relied on. Incorporation of documents by reference is not allowed. The Appeal Deciding Officer is Howard Sargent, Forest Supervisor.
