Just got off the phone with Michael Schuback, CEO of FGX Septech.in Kentucky (<http://www.fgxseptech.com/>). This company has a coal cleaning process that they want to install on SITLA lands near West Ridge Mine, to process West Ridge coal. Bruce Hill is his contact at the mine.

He asked about the permitting process, with the idea of getting this up and running in a very short time frame. I told him we had other critical items on our agenda right now and would not give his project an expedited review. He claims that in Kentucky, the only permit needed is from Air Quality, obtained in 30 days.

Anyway, he'll call back Monday for further discussion, and he'd like to set up a time to come visit with us and present his proposal in person. I checked the calendars and told him Nov 5-7 and 17-24 looked open.

How can we find out about this "air quality permit only" business? Who at OSM might be able to shed some light on this?
