Dear Mr. Spensko:

We are in receipt of your letter of June 10th and appreciate your compliance with the Utah Mined Land Reclamation Act.

In reviewing your drilling and plugging plans, our chief petroleum engineer, Patrick Driscoll, makes several suggestions. In reviewing the logs of the nearest drill holes in the area he suggests that *(1) numerous fresh-water bearing sands may be encountered.* In accordance with Rule M-3 (4) of the Act we recommend that all water bearing zones will be either cased or plugged to prevent the migration or intermingling of these fluids; *(2) most of these water bearing units will be within 250 feet of the surface and plugging from -250 feet to surface may be required to effectively prevent water mixing or discharge.*

Please contact the Division so we may reach some sort of agreement.

NOTICE OF INTENTION

Natural Gas Corporation of California, a subsidiary of Pacific Gas and Electric Company, 245 Market Street, San Francisco, California, 94106, is contemplating drilling a coal exploration hole in Section 2, Township 13 South, Range 12 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, Carbon County, Utah.

The hole will be located approximately 800 feet from the North line of the Section and approximately 250 feet from the West line of the Section. Plans are to drill the hole some time this summer or late fall or some time next year, depending upon the mobil equipment available.

Diameter of the hole will be 4.75 inches to 5 5/8 inches, depending upon equipment available. Total depth will be about 2700 feet. No cores will be taken, however the hole will be electronically logged. Approximate elevation is 7880 feet.

Upon completion of the hole it will be plugged as follows: 50 feet above the upper most coal seam will be plugged with neat cement grout, balance of the hole will be filled with drilling fluid, sodium bentonite or other drilling materials. The upper 5 feet of the hole will be filled with cement with a marker pipe of about 3 feet out of the ground. This procedure is in compliance with Abandonment of Drill Holes, Western Rocky Mountain Area.

Permission from the surface owners is pending.
