Dear Mr. Steele:

Your letter of March 3rd requesting a mining permit has been received by this Division. The application included with the letter, however, is only half of the necessary forms, apparently through an oversight, form MR-2 was not attached.

Included are two copies of MR-2 (mining and reclamation plan), one for your use, and the other for the formal filing with this Division. If, however, you have formulated a reclamation plan for the U.S.G.S. or the U.S.F.S., this should be usable in place of the MR-2. We do not want you to duplicate your efforts. As we discussed previously, a surety covering the cost of reclamation on the surface fee acreage will be needed. In your case, surety will probably take the form of the Board recognizing Valley Camp's assets in Utah, so cash or a bond as such would not be needed.

Since my visit to the Belina #1 informed me of some of the details of that operation, I can possibly answer some of your questions by telephone. If you need any assistance on MR-2 or another reclamation plan, please contact me at this office.
