Dear Mr. Steele:

The Division received no written objections of substance to the mining and reclamation plan for the Belina No. 1 Mine during the thirty (30) day period subsequent to publishing the abbreviated plan for public notice. An adjacent landowner did however express a verbal concern relative to the dust which might be caused by trucks running on the road from the portal to Eccles Canyon. Concern centered mainly on the effects of the dust upon surrounding ecologic regimes.

This impact could or could not be significant and in any case we feel you should be apprised of same to make a conscious effort to mitigate the possible dust problem by whatever means is practical. It is our feeling that a road sprinkling program during times of high dust potential would be a reasonable attempt at mitigation.

Your Notice of Intent to Commence Mining Operations, and Mining and Reclamation Plan therefore are granted final approval pending the posting of suitable surety in the amount shown on the enclosed reclamation surety estimate. In addition, copies of the various alternative filing forms are enclosed.
