Pursuant to our conversation at your office on November 27, 1979 as related to "Mining Permit Applications - Minimum Requirements," it is our desire to have the Division of Wildlife Resources furnish particular information and recommendations, to Valley Camp of Utah, Inc., which would assist us in preparation of our permit application.

The specific information we would require is set forth in section 783.20 and 784.21 of the Permanent Regulatory Program. (copies of sections attached.)

Due to the variation in geologic surroundings and environmental differences related to the 1,100 foot elevation separation between the Utah No. 2 Mine and the Belina No. 1 Mine, we would require each site to be addressed individually.

A map of the area indicating mine perimeters, mine portals, surface facility locations, proposed overland conveyor routes and other related information is enclosed for your considerations.
