The above operation was visited on December 17, 1979 for the purpose of a follow-up inspection by Division personnel Joe Helfrich and Doug Stewart. The time of the visit was 5:00 p.m. All management personnel had departed at 4:30 p.m. Three violations written by the Office of Surface Mining on December 4, 1979, were checked.

1. Violation #1 - Material placed on downslope below road cut. No additional material has been placed since the time the violation was first viewed and ordered stopped immediately.
2. Violation #2 - Failure to pass surface drainage from the disturbed area through sedimentation ponds. Sedimentation pond now complete for outlet works, but needs some smoothing and dressing up. Surface facilities drainage is now directed by gutters into sedimentation pond.
3. Violation #3 - Failure to maintain access and haul roads as required. All drop culverts are now physically connected by runoff gutters and are free and clear of debris.
