The above mentioned operation was given a follow-up inspection on January 8, 1980, by Ron Gregg and Vernon E. Maldonado from the Office of Surface Mining, and Doug Stewart and Joe Helfrich from the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining.

During the previous inspection of December 4, 1979 by the Office of Surface Mining and State personnel, one drainage problem was noted. The area between the fan portal and 36" culvert that drains into the sediment pond was being stockpiled with snow from the fan portal access road. At that time drainage through the culvert was not an eminent problem, however, it was suggested that the snow be removed to another area to prevent clogging of the culvert. During the recent inspection it was evident that the snow pile had not been removed and additional snow had been placed in front of the culvert. The following violation was issued: Failure to maintain culvert which drains access road. No other violations were issued.
