The above mentioned operation was given a follow-up inspection by Ron Gregg and Vernon E. Maldonado from the Office of Surface Mining and Doug Stewart and Joe Helfrich from the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining. Federal and State inspectors were accompanied by Joe Shoemaker, Chief Engineer, at Valley Camp.

The purpose of the trip was to acquaint the Office of Surface Mining inspectors with surface layout of the Belina Mine.

During the previous inspection of December 4, 1979, by State and Federal inspectors three violations were issued, (see Valley Camp Memo dated December 18, 1979). The Office of Surface Mining was informed by Valley Camp personnel of abatement measures taken on the existing violations. A follow-up inspection was conducted on December 17, 1979 as requested in a previous phone conversation between Larry Damrau and Mike Thompson to confirm abatement measures enacted by Valley Camp (see Valley Camp Memo dated December 18, 1979).

No violations were issued.
