The above mentioned operation was given a full inspection by Larry Damrau from the Office of Surface Mining and Joe Helfrich from the Division on February 19, 1980. State and Federal inspectors were accompanied by Joe Shoemaker, Chief Surveyor, at Valley Camp.

Inspectors viewed the following areas:

1. The culvert between the fan and northern most sediment pond has been cleared of compacted snow. This violation was terminated.
2. Considerable progress has been made on the south sediment pond near the conveyor system, ie., the southern end of the pond has been rip-rapped and overflow inlet boxes have been installed.
3. The middle pond has straw bales placed at the upper end in addition to rip-rapping to prevent head cutting and decrease streamflow velocity.
4. Inspectors were very pleased with the maintenance of the inlet boxes and diversion ditches at the Belina #1 and #2 Mines.

No violations were issued.
