
The Division staff has given a cursory review to the grading and drainage plan for the Belina #1 Mine. The Division feels that the conceptual plans for the grading, drainage and sediment control are acceptable and should be presented in final form. The Division hereby grants construction approval to allow Valley Camp Coal to go ahead with construction to facilitate repairs to the main Belina sediment pond. In doing so, the excavation, fill construction and grading of the silo area is approved at this time with the following stipulations:

1. If following Division review, any problems or areas of concern are found in the Valley Camp Coal Company's plans for grading and drainage control, Valley Camp must correct or modify plans for on the ground compliance to conform with the regulations and performance standards.
2. Sediment control measures must be implemented during the construction phase to provide for protection of the hydrologic balance and prevention of additional contributions of sediment to the stream.
