We received the December 2, 1981, request from Valley Camp of Utah, Inc. requesting regulatory approval to extend development and production of coal from Belina No. 2 mine into Federal coal lease U-020305.

On April 6, 1981, we responded to the mine plan for Belina No. 2 mine with our review and comments. We sited several requirements for the plan to meet the needs of the USGS. To date, to our knowledge, these needs have not been met. However, we have no objection to an approval for the company to develop main entry systems into Federal coal in accordance with the line projections for the Belina No. 2 mine that accompany its request in order for it to maintain production requirements. The projections are columnized under the Belina No. 1 mine development and meet the requirement of this office in that respect.

Full approval of the mine plan should not be made until the requirements of the enclosed April 6, 1981, memo have been received from Valley Camp and our concurrence has been submitted in a memo to you.
