On March 27, 1981, Tom Portle and Joe Helfrich from the Division visited Trevor Whiteside of Valley Camp to determine if compliance measures discussed on March 25, 1981 (see Valley Camp memo dated May 12, 1981, for details), had been completed.

Required measures to bring Valley Camp into compliance had been performed:

1. Trash had been cleared from the area near their construction activities on the north end the middle pad overlooking the sediment pond.
2. The ditch had been better established to help convey water from this area to the sediment pond.
3. A culvert had been installed under the conveyor to bring water from this area down over the embankment.
4. Above the area which had displayed erosion on the downslope, a berm had been established to keep water in the ditch and bring it down onto the pad without eroding this downslope.

On the next inspection, these areas should be checked to see if erosion has progressed since the areas are a very loose type material. Mr. Whiteside was informed that it would be wise to implement some type of an erosion prevention device directly under the culvert below the conveyor to lessen the potential of erosion in this area.

No violations were issued.
