Dear Mr. Durham:

From our review of the above referenced draft permit and public notice dated July 9, 1982, it is hereby certified that the proposed conditions to be imposed for said permit should result in compliance with applicable State water quality standards provided the Total Dissolved Solids is limited to a daily maximum of 700 mg/l. This TDS limitation is currently achieved by the company and will further ensure compliance with the Colorado River Salinity standards as referenced by Section 2.4 of the Utah Wastewater Disposal Regulations.

It is further certified that to the best of our knowledge no other applicable effluent limitation or other limitation under Section 208e, 301, 302, 303, 306 and 307 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as amended (33 U.S.C. 466 et. seq.) presently exist.
