This letter is to notify you and other interested agencies of the evaluation by the Utah Bureau of Water Pollution Control of your fill material placement and runoff control measures. This evaluation is based upon the October 7, 1982 inspection by Fred Pehrson and myself.

The berm which you constructed below the original disposal area appeared to be an improvement of the original inadequate runoff control provisions. As discussed during our inspection, an emergency overflow pipe or spillway would be recommended to lessen the potential of overtopping the berm. If fill material is to be stored in this area again, additional information must be submitted to this office including a diagram of increased berm width, pond volume, freeboard, surface area drained and other appropriate information to demonstrate an adequate water pollution control program. For your information I am enclosing Parts I-III of the Utah Wastewater Disposal Regulations.

The present disposal site above the town of Clear Creek should be inspected periodically to ensure that storm runoff is not causing any water quality problems.

You may call me at 533-6146 if you have any questions regarding surface runoff control requirements of our agency. Your cooperation in this matter has been appreciated.
