RE: Sediment Pond No. 3 - Modification

Dear Mr. Smith:

As you are aware, on July 21, 1982, Mr. Joseph Helfrich issued to Valley Camp of Utah, Inc., Notice of Violation No. N82-1-9-2. This violation was issued for coal being placed in the No. 3 Sediment Pond at the Utah No. 2 Load-Out Facility.

In an effort to abate the violation, coal was removed from pond and sediment which had accumulated in the pond over the years was also removed. In the process of cleaning the pond, and in consideration of the possible occurrence of coal again being pushed into the pond area, we decided to enlarge the pond by deepening the southern portion and modifying the elevation of each decant pipe. This would allow for storage of the required sediment volume and the water storage capacity, and at the same time, reduce the area required for total storage, thereby creating additional storage area for coal in times of emergency at the north end of the old pond.

Enclosed for your consideration, please find three (3) copies of Drawing No. C5-0028 revised, depicting the pond as it is now constructed.

I hope this revision meets with your approval.
