A general overview tour was conducted at Valley Camp on October 14, 1982 with eight persons in attendance: Jim Smith (DOGM); Tom Tetting (DOGM); Pamela Grubaugh-Littig (DOGM); Floyd Johnson (OSM); Sarah Bransom (OSM); Robert Lytle (Envirosphere); Jack Palantz (Envirosphere); and, Bill Hahn (Envirosphere). Trevor Whiteside led the tour for Valley Camp. Before the tour began, a discussion of the problem with coal in the sedimentation pond #3 at Utah #2 was held.

A tour of the Belina Complex was given. The filter pond, sedimentation pond, stockpiles, stacker and loadout were observed.

At the Utah #2 loadout, the various alternatives were discussed for removal of the coal in sedimentation pond #3. This action had a 90-day period to be corrected, final day being Monday, October 18, 1982. The alternatives included curtailing coal stockpiling at Utah #2 and clearing the sedimentation pond of coal to meet the capacity requirements for the 10-yr, 24-hour event. The most appropriate site was selected in the vicinity.
