



Memo to Coal File

RE: Valley Camp of Utah
Utah #2 Loadout
ACT/007/014
Carbon County, Utah

The above mentioned operation had a partial inspection on October 20, 1982 by Joseph C. Helfrich, Field Supervisor for the Division. He was accompanied Trevor Whiteside, Senior Mining Engineer for the Valley Camp operation. The purpose of the trip was to terminate NOV N82-1-9-2, #1 of 2, issued July 21, 1982. Abatement work for the violation had been completed on Tuesday, October 19, 1982. This work consisted of cleaning out the south sediment pond at the Utah #2 Loadout operation. In addition to the removal of coal from the sediment pond, approximately four (4) feet of material was removed from the bottom of the sediment pond to facilitate additional sediment storage and/or runoff volume. Additional berming had been implemented along the north side of the pond to prevent coal from entering the pond. The pond had been surveyed three times during the coal cleaning and additional excavation work. A narrative and map describing the abatement will be forthcoming.
