RE: Extension for NOV-N82-1-9-2

Dear Mr. Whiteside:

Pursuant to your request for extension of compliance deadlines for both violations contained in NOV N82-1-9-2, I have extended the deadline to October 19, 1982 for violation #1 and November 7, 1982 for violation #2. These time frames extend the abatement deadline to the full 90 days as allowed in our State statute under section 40-10-22 (1)(c) UZA 1953 as amended. The second of the two violations was allowed an additional 19 days to compensate for the administrative delay involved with obtaining approval for the reconstruction of the mine water filter pond.

The Office of Surface Mining in their preliminary oversight review of the State, has shown some concern to abatement deadlines which extend beyond the 90 day abatement time. Although I have not granted the full 60 days as requested in your letter of September 16, 1982, it is hoped that the additional time granted will be ample to assure on the ground compliance at your operation.
