Dear Mr. Whiteside:

Enclosed please find Notice of Violation N82-4-11-1. The violation was observed on September 30 during an inspection conducted by myself and Tom Munson of the Division. As discussed with you during our October 5, 1982 phone conversation, the NOV is issued for failure to maintain sedimentation ponds #2 and #3 in order to prevent short-circuiting and failure to meet applicable State and Federal effluent limitations. The remedial actions require the repair of the sediment pond's discharge structures and the time for abatement is October 8, 1982.

As I understood from our phone conversation, the discharge from the sediment ponds had ceased by 2:30 p.m., on the date of the inspection, and on October 4, 1982, you had a contractor working on the discharge structure of the sediment ponds in an attempt to mitigate the problem. The Division appreciates your prompt response to the problem. If you have any questions concerning this violation, please do not hesitate to call me.
