

Dear Mr. Whiteside:

The Division has received and reviewed your October 28th revision to Sediment Pond #3 at the Utah No. 2 Loadout facility. It has been determined that additional information will be required, or cross-referenced to previously submitted material in order to complete the revision review. This material must include the following:

1. Information regarding the disturbed and/or undisturbed area which currently drains into sediment Pond No. 3.
2. The storm volume and sediment volume calculations for the previous pond (and recently modified pond if different).
3. The volume and configuration of previous pond.
4. The drainage design and calculations for the previous pond (if different from new pond).
5. The proposed methods to insure that coal in the emergency storage area is kept isolated from the new sediment pond.
