Enclosed are the following materials for your review:

1. February 7, 1983 transmittal letter from the Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining to Valley Camp with the most recent changes to the Apparent Completeness Review (ACR),
2. OSM report on the February 2, 1983 meeting with Valley Camp, and
3. Copy of Valley Camp's November, 1982 revision of its mine plan.

I would appreciate it if you would insert the November, 1982 revisions into your copy of the mine plan. Also the two referenced maps, "Reclamation Map D-1" and "Plate 6-A: Ground Water Contours" are not available at this time; however, you may use OSM's mine plan file copies available in our office.

I met briefly with Tom Tetting on February 10, 1983 to discuss the status of Valley Camp's submission of the remaining mine plan information. He requested that Envirosphere pay particular attention in the Technical Analysis to subsidence issues around the Mountain Fuels gas pipeline. I suggest you contact Tom directly to further investigate the nature of the State's concern. Also, I suggest you review and discuss with Tom the State's changes to 784.22 Diversions, found on page 9 of the revised ACR.
