Re: Cleaning of Sediment Pond No. 2

Dear Mr. Smith:

From previous discussions and correspondence, you are aware of our need to clean out the No. 2 sediment pond located at the entrance to the Utah No. 2 mine area. With the availability of a dragline in the mine area, plans have been made to begin cleaning this pond the week of September 26, 1983.

The material taken from the pond will be mixed with material acquired from the removal of the old access road into this area, and will then be compacted into place on the south slope (pad) area between the coal stacking pad and Sediment Pond No. 3. The specific location of disposal is shown on the enclosed drawing.

The material to be removed from the pond will consist primarily of coal dust and road sediment, and should be very acceptable for its intended use as coal storage pad. In addition to cleaning the pond, we will be enlarging and improving the emergency coal storage area between the stock out pad and Pond No. 3. Please refer to Map No. C5-0028, submitted to you on October 3, 1982, for greater detail of the disposal area.

Sediment Pond No. 3 will not be disturbed during this process.
