Re: Technical Deficiency Review

Dear Mr. Smith:

On September 16, 1983, Valley Camp of Utah, Inc. submitted to the Division, and to the Office of Surface Mining, thirteen (13) copies of their response to the Division's "Technical Deficiency Review". Incomplete items of that response were at that time listed in the cover letter. The follow-up response for those items is hereby submitted under separate cover. The specific items found in this submittal, and which are to be included into Volume No. 6, are as follows:

1. Table of Contents - Page 2 has been revised, remove and discard page 2 dated 9-15-83.
2. UMC 782.21 - Newspaper advertisement and Proof of Publication. New pages 782.21-3, 782.21-4 are to be added to this section behind Figure 1-1.
3. UMC 783.15/784.14 - Ground Water Information. Revised page 783.15/784.14 replaces same page dated 15 September 1983.

Specific geologic cross-sections of the Belina No. 1 mine (Drawing Nos. D1-0089 and D1-0090) are to be placed in Appendix B of Appendix N.

Revised Appendix B, Introduction Sheet, replaces same one dated 15 September 1983.

4. UMC 784.13 (b) (4) - Reclamation Plan: General Requirements (Topsoil).

Revised page 784.13 (b) (4)-1 replaces same one dated 7 September 1983.

New Appendix P is submitted for this section and is to be placed behind Maps in Volume VI. Site material analysis and location maps are included.

5. UMC 784.15 - Reclamation Plan: Post-Mining Land Uses.

A post-mining land use change from wildlife habitat has not been proposed. However, the applicant attempted to obtain "support" letters from the landowners as well as the UDOGM, U.S.F.W.S., and UDWR, for the proposed post-mining land uses, in hopes of assisting the approval process on this particular section.

At this time, only the Utah Division of Wildlife Resources has responded. Their comments were submitted to the Division as per their M.O.U. and the applicant did not receive a copy.

The landowners have again chosen not to comment.

6. UMC 784.24 - Transportation Facilities (Belina Haul Road and Proposed Conveyor).

As built drawings (Nos. T-1, P-1, and sheets 1 through 7) are submitted for insertion into Map folder T-1.

7. 817.101 (b)(4)(iii) - Backfilling and Grading: General Requirements.

A Geotechnical Investigation of cut slopes and the Haul Road at the Belina Complex, prepared by Morrison-Knudsen Company, Inc., is submitted for insertion into Volume VI as Appendix L.

For your review, six (6) copies of this supplemental response will be hand carried to your office, and at the same time seven (7) copies will be hand delivered to the OSM Offices in Denver.
