Re: Coal Haulage on Public Roads

Dear Mr. Daniels:

The enclosed map exhibits roads utilized by Valley Camp for the purpose of coal transportation within our mine plan area.

As you will see in examining the map, one route provides for both coal haulage and access to and from the Belina Mine and Load-out facility. This route, starting at the Belina Complex, consists of 1.8 miles of private road, 2.6 miles of State Highway (No. 96), and 0.2 miles of private road.

The two sections of private road are subject to the performance standards promulgated pursuant to Section 40-10-1, et seq., Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, and as such, are included in Valley Camp's submitted Mine Plan Application. Once this application is approved, these portions of our haul road will then be permitted and, as a result, maintained according to regulations governing such haul roads.

The section of State Highway 96 most assuredly meets the requirements of a public road definition and, therefore, qualifies as an exemption to these regulations.

In addition, and also shown on the enclosed map, approximately 0.2 miles of private road provides access to Valley Camp's administration building. This road is not used for coal haulage, but it is also included in our permit.


