The Division has evaluated Valley Camp of Utah's response to the Technical deficiencies review for the Mining and Reclamation Plan at the Belina Complex. Generally speaking, the company has adequately addressed the deficiencies as they relate to wildlife. At which time that the conveyor is finally designed for construction, the company should be required to develop a monitoring plan to evaluate big game passage. It appears that such a study plan will not be essential within the permit period (the next five years).
