On October 7, 1982, a partial inspection was conducted at the above-mentioned minesite by Division Inspectors David Lof and John Whitehead. They were accompanied on the inspection by Trevor Whiteside of Valley Camp. The purpose of the inspection was to determine the status of NOV N82-4-11-1.

Upon inspection of sediment ponds #2 and #3, it was apparent that the water level was below the principal discharge structure and that no discharge was occurring. The operator had had a contractor put a rubber strip around the culvert joint and tighten the band holding the two culverts together down on the rubber strip to try and seal the leak. Mr. Whiteside said that this work had been completed on October 4. Inspectors subsequently terminated NOV 82-4-11-1, at the time of the inspection, and made the effective date of termination October 4, 1982.
