On September 30, 1982, a partial inspection was conducted at the above-mentioned minesite by David Lof and Tom Munson of the Division. They were accompanied on the inspection by Trevor Whiteside of Valley Camp. While in Mr. Whiteside's office, Mr. Lof gave Mr. Whiteside a Modification of Notice from Joe Helfrich extending the deadline on NOV N82-1-9-2.

There was approximately two to three feet of snow at the minesite at the time of the inspection. Work had been started on the new filter ponds but had been interrupted by the weather. Mine water discharge was being routed through the sediment pond. The sediment pond was full of water, in fact, it appeared as though the water may have been discharging through the primary discharge. However, we could not be sure and the discharge point was inaccessible due to the snow.
