On April 27, 1983, Tom Tetting, Everett Hooper and Shannon Storrud met with Steve Tanner, Trevor Whiteside, E. B. Foust, Bob Plinn, Bob Burns and Larry Thomas of Valley Camp of Utah, Inc., and CEI Consulting Engineers, Inc. Modifications to the Belina Mine Road were discussed. CEI Engineering presented the final technical design and proposed bid arrangement.

Valley Camp expressed an urgent concern to start this project by May 23 due to the limited construction season and present economics. There is also a concern in dealing with excess rock generated from the road modification. It was suggested by Valley Camp to rebuild a sediment pond with it but as of yet no final plan has been submitted. CEI expects to submit a plan within the next week addressing all the environmental considerations.

Upon complete review and inspection of the existing road, it is generally felt that the road modification will be an excellent operation and environmental improvement. Therefore, I feel the permitting should be expedited as soon as possible.
