On August 24, 1983 Ken Wyatt of the Division conducted an inspection at the Valley Camp facilities. The purpose of this inspection was to collect water samples in relation to Cessation Order No. C83-1-1-1. The water sample of the sediment pond No. 4 discharge was collected at 3:17pm. Also a water sample of the sedimentation pond influent from the mine water was collected at the point that it enters the sediment pond from the culvert at 3:20pm. The results of these analyses indicated TSS levels of 130 mg/l for the influent and 43 mg/l for the sediment pond discharge. No other compliance problems were encountered.
