On August 18, 1983, I conducted a partial inspection at the above mentioned site. The purpose of the inspection was to obtain a water sample of the operators sediment pond discharge and to check on the construction status of the operators mine water filter pond. I was accompanied on the inspection by Ed Sanderson, of Valley Camp.

At the time of the inspection the sediment pond was discharging at a rate of approximately 45 gallons per minute. A sample was taken of the discharge and the sample sent to the Utah State Department of Health for analysis. The water analysis indicated a TSS level of 23 mg/l.

The operator had completed construction of the forms for the filter pond, and was planning on pouring the cement for the pond the following day.
