Dear Mr. Whiteside:

The proposed truck scale/loadout/access road modification to Valley Camp's interim permit as proposed in your July 25, 1983 correspondence to the Division, is hereby approved upon the Division's receipt of Valley Camp's written acceptance of the following stipulation. This stipulation was agreeable to both you and the Division staff during a telephone conversation on August 17, 1983.

Stipulation 8-17-83-TM

Valley Camp must develop and implement an alternative "permanent" sediment control method for the access road and any disturbance to the adjacent hillside. The use of straw bales is not acceptable as a "permanent" measure for sediment control. The proposed alternative method must be acceptable to the Division staff and implemented prior to completion of the new installation. Whether it be rock gabions, a ditch and berm to the sediment pond, or any other adequate method, it must be determined on-site by the Division staff and implemented by Valley Camp to make this approval valid.

It is important to note that during the construction period temporary sediment controls must be provided for the new disturbance, i.e., straw bales at the outlet of the highway ditch or along the disturbed area perimeter.

Additionally, copies of this modification must be provided to the OSM and the Division as required to update the Valley Camp MRP.

Your written acceptance of this stipulation must be received by the Division prior to any new construction activity in this area. Two copies of this letter are provided, the second which you may sign and forward to the Division as proof of acceptance. Upon receipt of the signed copy by the Division, final approval for the truck scales/access road will be granted and construction can proceed. Should you have any questions, please call.
