Violation No. 1 of 1

Nature of the Violation

Failure to pass all surface drainage from the disturbed area through a sedimentation pond, a series of sedimentation ponds or a treatment facility before leaving the permit area. Failure to maintain sediment control facilities to prevent to the extent possible additional contributions of sediment to stream flow or runoff outside the permit area.
