Dear Mr. Smith:

This letter is to inform the Division that Valley Camp has re-identified the existing perimeters of the Utah No. 2 Mine and Load-out facilities and the Belina Complex, using a combination of visuals comprised of tee posts and plastic shim stock.


In the non-forestation areas, four foot tee posts, painted red, were used as markers; while in the dense quakies and pines, the amber plastic shim stock in two and one half by twenty inch strips, was attached to the trees with lead head nails.

The new markers were installed as an additional visual aid to the existing redhead stakes.

The distance between markers varies, with the visibility ranging from 50 to 300 feet.
