Dear Mr. Klein:

Under cover of your letter of October 14, 1983, you sent Valley Camp the results of the Office of Surface Mining's (OSM) review of Valley Camp's September 16, 1983, response to the August 9, 1983, draft Determination of Adequacy (DOA) letter. In this package, picked up by Mr. Walter L. Wright, review comments were given relating to 19 regulatory sections.

In Valley Camp's subsequent response of November 16, 1983, to these comments, all sections were responded to, with the exception of UMC 761.11(a)(3), "Areas Unsuitable for Mining-Protection of Cultural Resources". This was due to the wintertime conditions, which disallowed performing the required field work. The OSM deadline for submission of the required information was given as December 31, 1984.

Valley Camp contracted for the performance of the required 100% pedestrian survey over the areas chosen by OSM with Archeological-Environmental Research Corporation. This survey was performed in August, 1984. A copy of ARCON's report is enclosed for your review.

By this submittal, compliance with OSM's October 14, 1983, PAP Inadequacies is now complete.
