On May 8, 1984 a partial inspection of Valley Camp loadout area was conducted by Ken Wyatt Field Specialist for the Division. Steve Tanner of Valley Camp accompanied this inspector on the field tour. The purpose of the inspection was to examine a fire on the Utah #2 portal pad area and to determine the source of the fire and whether or not Valley Camp had the appropriate burning permits.

During this inspection Mr. Ray Reddington was contacted at the loadout offices. It was apparent at this time that the source of the fire was railroad ties that had been set on fire adjacent to the railroad tracks. This is a common practice of the railroad to burn old ties along the railroad right of way. No compliance problems were indicated at this time. The weather was clear and cool.
