Compliance with Permanent Performance Standards

Applicable permits and approvals available at the mine office included:

A May 11, 1978 letter from Ron Daniels granting interim approval to operate.

Approval for the operation of the Belina #2 Mine was granted on June 10, 1981, in a letter from Jim Smith.

A Division of Water Rights stream alteration permit was examined. This permit #668 dated April 26, 1984, and signed by Richard Hall, allows the realignment of Eccles Creek around the recent slide on the south slope of Eccles Canyon just east of the Valley Camp turnoff.

A letter from Steve Tanner of Valley Camp to Jim Smith dated May 29, 1984, indicated that the realignment work has been completed.

817.11 Signs and Markers

The mine identification sign, buffer zone markers and perimeter markers were observed posted in appropriate areas. Since the spring thaw is completed, Valley Camp should inspect and repair any signs that have been impacted from the winter. New perimeter markers are slated for installation at the loadout and at the mine area.
