A partial inspection of the Valley Camp facilities was conducted by Ken Wyatt and Tom Wright, Field Specialists for the Division on August 10, 1984. Keith Fenstermaker of Valley Camp accompanied these inspectors.

Valley Camp intends to clean Sediment Pond #4 as partial abatement to Notice of Violation N84-7-6-1. This pond was set up to be decanted utilizing pumps at the discharge standpipe. A series of strawbales and filter cloths were installed in the drainage below the discharge point.

At this time water was being pumped into the discharge standpipe. A sample of the discharge water was collected at 2:35 p.m. below the lowest strawbale/filter cloth structure. This sample is currently being analyzed by the Utah State Health Laboratory.

Valley Camp has agreed to dewater the pond using pumps so long as effluent limitations can be met. When pumping near the sediment level and questionable water is encountered, a water truck will be utilized to haul water from the Belina Mine site to a sediment pond at Valley Camp's loadout. No problems were encountered at this time.
