Re: Approval of Rechannalization of Eccles Creek, Belina Mine,
Valley Camp of Utah, ACT/007/001, Folder Nos. 2, 3 and 4,
Carbon County, Utah

The Division's technical staff has reviewed the plans and information submitted May 31, 1984, and July 27, 1984. The rechannalization efforts have resulted in a stabilized stream channel with a channel and flood plain capable of passing the 100-year, 24-hour peak flow. Also, Valley Camp has committed to revegetate the slide area to minimize erosion and to prevent additional contribution of suspended sediment. Therefore, the Division finds that Valley Camp has complied with the requirements of UMC 817.44.

Based on these findings, the Division hereby approves the rechannalization of Eccles Creek. The Division's inspection and technical staff will monitor the revegetation efforts on the slide area. If you have any questions, please call.
