Re: Cleaning of Belina Sediment Pond, Belina Mine, Valley Camp of Utah, ACT/007/001, Folder No. ② & 3, Carbon County, Utah

A review of your 12 October 1984 submittal regarding the cleaning of Sediment Pond No. 4 at the Belina Mine has resulted in the following comments and concerns:


1. The Division staff has conducted an extensive search of all files, looking for the Vaughn Hansen Compliance Report, submitted to the Division in 1979. We have been unable to locate this report, although we can locate correspondence related to it. As Valley Camp is making continuing reference to this report, it is necessary that a copy be available to assist and facilitate the Division's Hydrology reviews associated with Valley Camp's Belina Complex. The Division requests that Valley Camp submit an additional copy of the VHA report.
2. To eliminate any future concerns and to provide a "paper-trail" for future reviewers to follow, if not contained in the VHA report; Valley Camp must submit a correct map delineating the total 27.5 acre drainage area to sediment pond #4. This map should indicate: all drainage below the undisturbed area diversions; below creek by-pass culverts; and drainage from all pads.
3. According to point 1 in your 9 October 1984 response, you indicate that with the construction of the sewer treatment plant the total disturbed area equals 30 acres. Why then is 27.5 acres used in the sediment pond calculation? Should not 30.0 acres be used?
