RE: NOV #N85-2-12-1, Belina Mine Complex, ACT/007/001, File #7,
Carbon County, Utah

Enclosed is Notice of Violation (NOV) #1 of 1, N85-2-12-1, resulting from the unpermitted activity, enlarging Sediment Pond #2, at the Utah #2 loadout. The abatement requirements of this NOV were discussed over the phone with you on August 2, 1985, a 30 day abatement time frame was agreed to, the deadline on this time frame is September 1, 1985.

The following information must be provided, at a minimum, to adequately address the NOV by the abatement deadline:

1. Provide certified as-built design specifications for Sediment Pond #2 which clearly address the applicable standards of UMC 817.46 and which update all information provided in the MRP. A survey and map of the sediment pond, certified by a Registered Professional Engineer, must also be submitted.
2. Submit soil samples of the material excavated from the extension of the sediment pond to a laboratory for analysis no later than August 14, 1985. An analysis of the soils must address the suitability guidelines for topsoil pursuant to UMC 817.22(e) and the enclosed Draft Guidelines. Provide verification that the soil samples have been submitted to a laboratory for analysis.

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

3. Until the DOGM has an opportunity to evaluate the quality of the soil excavated from the sediment pond extension, Valley Camp must keep it segregated and adequately protected from erosion and contaminants. Submit plans which indicate the volume of the material excavated in extension of the sediment pond, designate a storage site for the excavated material and describe measures to be implemented to protect the soil from erosion and contamination.
