I spoke with Ron Naten on the telephone on March 6, 1985 regarding the OSM reviewed bonds for Valley Camp of Utah, Inc., and Price River Coal Company. The Valley Camp bond is in 1983 dollars. The 79.1 acres of disturbance existing there and on th bond estimate are being questioned by the operator. Trevor Whitesides contends that there are about 70 acres not 79.1.

The work-up of the Price River bond was requested. The escalation factor is not the Division factor.

One of the goals for bonding this year is to put all of the operations on an annual update and review.
