Re: Notice of Violation Review N85-2-12-1, Belina Complex, Valley Camp of Utah, ACT/UU7/001, Folder No. 3 and 7, Carbon County, Utah

The Division of Oil, Gas and Mining's technical staff has reviewed the material submitted August 28, 1985 relating to items 1 and 4 of violation N85-2-12-1. Based upon the Division review of the submitted plans, item No. 1 required submission of "as-built" designs for sediment pond No. 2. These plans are hereby approved and accepted by the Division. Item No. 4, requiring submission of plans describing volume storage and intended use of the soil cannot be approved based upon the data submitted in the Ford Chemical analysis. There are inaccuracies in the data submitted which appear to indicate that this material is not suitable as topsoil substitute material. It is the recommendation of the Division that an additional soil sample(s) be taken and analyzed by an alternative company to allow comparison of the data results.

Our apologies for the delay incurred in responding to your November 12, 1985 letter of inquiry. We appreciate your patience and cooperation in resolving the remaining concerns.
