The undersigned representative finds that cessation of mining is is not expressly or in practical effect required by this Notice. For this purpose "Mining" means extracting coal from the earth or a waste pile and transporting it within or from the minesite.

This Notice shall remain in effect until it expires as provided on the reverse or is modified, terminated or vacated by written notice of an authorized representative of the Director of the Division of Oil, Gas & Mining. The time for abatement may be extended by the authorized representative for good cause, if a request is made within a reasonable time before the end of the abatement period.

Violation No. 1 of 2

Nature of the Violation

Failure to maintain runoff diversions in order to pass all surface drainage from the disturbed area through a sedimentation pond.

Provision(s) of the Regulations, Act, or Permit Violated

UMC 817.42(a)(1)

UMC 817.45

UCA 40-10-18(2)(i)(ii)

Portion of the Operation to which Notice Applies

Drainage diversion along base of Stacker pad and truck dump.

Remedial Action Required (including interim steps, if any)

Reconstruct & maintain the diversion to meet design standards of UMC 817.43(a) for a 10 year - 24 hour precipitation event & UMC 817.43 (F)(2) requiring a minimum .3 foot freeboard. Submit sizing calculations, maps & cross sections of the drainage diversion for DGM review & approval.

Time for Abatement (including time for interim steps, if any)

1. Establish drainage controls to divert all disturbed area to a sedimentation pond within 2 weeks or by 3/20/85.
2. Submit diversion designs (or reference approved designs in MRP) within 30 days, or by 4/5/85.
3. Establish the drainage ditch to meet design standards by 4/5/85.

Nature of the Violation

Failure to maintain sediment control measures to function in accordance with approved designs.

Provision(s) of the Regulations, Act, or Permit Violated

UMC 817.45

UMC 77619

UCA 40-10-18(2)(i)(ii)

Drainage control plans for the Truck Scale Installation approved 8/13/83 & Rock Gabion filter designs submitted 7/25/84.

Portion of the Operation to which Notice Applies

A. Drainage from the area at the base of the truck dump, bypassing the culvert inlet to Sediment pond #2.

B. Truck Scale drainage area

C. Rock Gabion filters along the loadout access road.

Remedial Action Required (including interim steps, if any)

A. Divert drainage to the sediment pond & maintain diversion as necessary.

B. Establish adequate surface grades & maintain ditchline to divert drainage to sediment pond #2 as designed so that only drainage off the first 75' of access road flows through the gabion filters or Submit modification.

C. Maintain filters as designed. Remove sediment & replace straw.

Repair rock filter as necessary to ensure that the structure is well secured to

Time for Abatement (including time for interim steps, if any) prevent short circuiting around the rock on straw.

Two weeks or by 3/20/85.
