Dear Mr. Braxton:

In correspondence dated May 15, 1986, I was informed, through you, of the Division's position in regards to inspection of sediment ponds within the Valley Camp permit area. Please be informed that we have reviewed your letter, and will conform to your mandate of making inspections on a quarterly basis rather than annually, as provided by our permit. This change in inspection frequency will commence this month.

Please be aware that field conditions, due to snow cover, will more than likely preclude inspections during first and fourth quarters. Your understanding of this situation may, I hope, be interpreted as a waiver to the Division's mandated requirements.

Pond inspections will be conducted as required if the snow cover allows, but I am not anticipating making a formal waiver request of the Division if the inspections cannot be made.
