This letter is to inform you of non-compliance of our Daily Maximum Effluent Limitations of our Belina Sediment Pond No. 004.

The non-compliance of Discharge Point No. 004 occurred on June 27, 1986 in sample No. 172 showing total dissolved solids content of 705 mg/l. At this point in time, we do not know what to attribute this to, but we feel that this is an isolated incident and do not see this as a recurring problem.
