RE: Valley Camp of Utah, Inc., Belina Complex, Cleaning of Sedimentation Pond No. 004, ACT/007/001, Carbon County, Utah.

Summary: The Division received a request from Valley Camp (dated March 26, 1986) to approve a plan to clean the sediment pond (004) at the Belina Mine Complex. Following discussions with Trevor Whiteside at the Belina Minesite on June 2, 1986, it was determined that the above referenced proposal was not necessary. Mr. Whiteside has decided to change his plan for the removal and disposal of the sediments. Basically, his plan involves pumping the water and sediments from the pond into the mine. The sediments will be dewatered in the mine and the return flow will report to the sediment pond for additional treatment. The sediment pond will not need to be dewatered and no discharge from the pond will occur with this proposal. On June 6, 1986, I called Mr. Whitesides and he confirmed his intentions and said the proposal of March 26, 1986 was no longer needed. He will submit his new proposal for review soon. Therefore, this proposal will not need to be reviewed by this office.
