4.c. Sediment Ponds and Impoundments:

1) The Belina sediment pond is well below the primary point of discharge, some 2 to 3 feet. Because of cold temperatures there has been little runoff and the pond is still refilling from a recent cleaning this last fall.

2) The sediment ponds in the Utah #2 Loadout area are well below capacity or primary discharge level.

3) The Belina mine water pond was discharging, at approximately 50 gpm. The discharging water appeared very clear. Samples were collected.

4.d. Other Sediment Controls:

Ditches and berms at both Belina and Utah #2 are functionable and adequately maintained.

18. Support Facilities:

The operator is expanding the upper storage yard at Belina. Machine components have been moved over to one side and fill material is being graded onto the pad. According to Mr. Tanner the fill material originated from sediment pond cleaning and expansion.
