Re: NEW MRP BASE MAPS

Dear Mr. Braxton:

On November 10, 1987, Olympus Aerial Survey flew Valley Camp of Utahs surface facilities, which included the Belina complex, Belina haul road and the Val-Cam Loadout.

Olympus will draw new base maps for the upgrade of and to simplify the mine permit. These new base maps are to be scaled 1"=50' with 5 foot contour intervals, detailed such that "As Built" certification is achieved for all surface features requiring certification.

Due to a backlog of work, Olympus will not be able to complete the maps until mid-February and allowing 30 days for nomenclature and cross sectionings, you should receive the new permit base maps as early as April 1. This set of base maps will satisfy all the applicable portions of TDN #X87-02-006-015 TVB, of the recent OSM-UDOGM inspection conducted November 4 and 5, 1987. }?

It is Valley Camp's belief that sediment pond 004 was in fact certified correctly, as depicted on drawing No. B4-0039, submitted to the Division November 18, 1986 and received final approval from the Division November 24, 1986. }?
